

Riverside Park & Campground Agreement

Carroll County Conservation Board Welcomes You!

Electric & Water site \$14 per night (**50** or **30** AMP)

Non-Electric \$10 per night

Dump Station \$3 per camping vehicle (non-registered camper)

All registered campers must review our rules and regulations

REGISTERED CAMPERS

All registered campers must be at least 18 years of age & at least 21 years of age if offering alcoholic beverages. You agree that you are making the registration on behave of yourself and camping party at your campsite. You agree are fully responsible for the acts, negligence, or omissions of the members of your camping party while utilizing CCCB campground and facilities. Additionally, you agree that you have read and understand the policies and rules at Carroll County Conservation campgrounds. Violation of any state law, county park or recreation area rule or regulation by any member of your camping party is cause for the revocation of the camping permit and the entire camping party shall be required to leave.

REGISTRATION

lowa Codes 461A.47, 461A.48, 461A.49, 461A.50, & 461A.51

Check in time is at 5:30 AM and check out time is at 6:00 PM. All CCCB campgrounds are on a self-registration, first-come, first-serve basis. Registration envelopes can be found at the information & self-registration kiosk located at the campground.

ALL CAMPERS MUST REGISTER THE DAY YOU ARRIVED AND HAVE RECEIPT POSTED AT THE CAMPSITE.

No camping unit of any kind shall occupy any campsite more than 14 days, the camping unit must leave the campground for one night.

<u>Pre-pay:</u> A person may come out to the campgrounds and prepay for a camping spot, but a vehicle or camping trailer (NOT A TENT) must be parked in the numbered site. A trailer is defined as a unit that has the capability to use water, sewer, & electric hookups.

CAMPSITE

lowa Codes 461A.40, 461A.43

Your campsite should be kept in a clean and orderly manner at all times. Campers shall restore their campsite to the same condition or better than they found prior to leaving. Only **one** picnic table and fire ring per camping site, please do not take these items from other camp sites.

DO NOT PUT GARBAGE IN THE FIRE RINGS – DUMPSTERS ARE LOCATED IN THE CAMPGROUND FOR REFUSE & RECYCLING.

PARK HOURS

lowa Code 461A.46

Great Western Park is open to the public 5:00 AM - 10:30 PM. Quiet hours are from 10:30 PM - 5:00 AM, please respect other park users by keeping noise at a reasonable level. Any non-register camping visitors must exit the park **BY** 10:30 PM. Violators will be ticketed for noncompliance.

VEHICLES

lowa Code 461A.38

Only two vehicles per camp site allowed. All motorized vehicles must stay on roadways or in designated parking areas. Park roads are public roads and operators of motor vehicles must be operated by licensed drivers only. Mini bikes and various all-terrain vehicles are prohibited at all times from Great Western Park & all Carroll County Conservation Parks.

PETS

lowa Codes 461A.45 & 461A.43

ALL PETS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH OF NO MORE THAN 6FT. AT ALL TIMES. Park users must IMMEDIATELY clean up after their pets. Violators will be issued a \$75 ticket for noncompliance. Pets are not allowed inside Carroll County Conservation facilities.

ALCOHOL lowg Code 123.47

Kegs are not allowed in the campground, at Great Western Park, or any of CCCB parks. All laws of the state of lowa regarding consumption of alcohol will be strictly observed. Violations of state code will result in expulsion of the campground. Ensure compliance and respecting possession of alcohol by minors and agree to abide by all rules and regulations of the CCCB and State of lowa.

TENTS

Tents are allowed in the grassy areas around the campground at Great Western Park. Tent camping (non-electrical) is \$10.00 per tent per night. A small tent for kids under the age of 18 of the same family is also allowed with a larger tent at no additional charge.

FIREARMS AND WEAPONS

lowa Code 461A.42

Firearms and weapons are prohibited at Great Western Park Campground. Firearms are allowed at the rifle range only. All Firearms, weapons, and explosives are prohibited in all county parks except during hunting seasons in designated county hunting areas. Fireworks are prohibited at all times.

TREES & SHRUBS lowa Code 461A.41 & 461A.39

Trees and shrubbery must not be cut or damaged in any way. Berries, fruits, and mushrooms may be harvested in the park.
