## **Public Access Reminder**

*The Glissman Conservation Area, including the pond, has always been open to the public. With the addition of a new parking lot, visitor access will now be easier and more frequent. **Please see map.***

- *Designated Park hours: One-half hour before sunrise to 10:00 PM.*
- *The Dallas County Sheriff's Department has been notified and will patrol the area regularly after hours to ensure rules are followed.*

## **Private Rental Areas**

- *The rental house, yard, and driveway remain for renters only. Areas surrounding the house will be appropriately signed.*
- *The trail and pond are part of the Glissman Conservation Area, which is and has always been open to the public.*

## **New Procedures for Renters**

- *The entry gate at the beginning of the park will remain open at all times. Closed during inclement weather.*
- *At the new parking lot, there is a padlocked cable gate.*
- *On the back of the gate pole, you will find a lockbox (similar to the one at the house).*
- *This lockbox uses the same 4-digit code as the house. Inside is a key for the padlock.*
- *After using the key to unlock the padlock:*
  1. *Open the gate and drive through.*
  2. *Close the gate immediately after entering.*
  3. *At the end of your stay, return the key to the lockbox.*

## **Important Notes**

- *Please do not share the code with anyone outside your rental group.*
- *Closing the gate helps maintain security and limits unwanted vehicle traffic.*
- *If you notice any suspicious activity, you may contact the Dallas County Sheriff's Department. For emergencies, dial 911; for non-emergencies, dial **515-993-4567**.*
