






The Heart of Iowa Nature Trail and the High Trestle Trail meet in Slater. Trailheads are located off R38 (Lynn Street) on the north edge of town and north of Highway 210 on the west side of town. Parking, water, and restrooms are available



The Huxley trailhead is located on Railroad and Third Streets. Facilities include parking, water, restrooms, and a picnic shelter. The trail through town is paved. Equestrians should use the city streets rather than the trail.




The Cambridge trailhead is located on the south edge of town on 585th Avenue (Vine Street). Additional parking, water, and picnic areas can be found at the City Park under the water tower on Second and River Streets.



Parking, water, and restrooms facilities for the trail at Maxwell can be found at the city park located one block west of Main on Second Street and at the trailhead at First and Woodlawn Street.



The Collins trailhead with parking, water, and restroom is located on the south edge of town on Railway Street. Parking is also provided at the developed trail three miles east of Collins on 730th Avenue just north of the intersection with 310th Street.



The Rhodes trailhead is located on the south end of Main Street. Facilities include parking, water, restrooms, and a picnic shelter. The trail from Rhodes to Melbourne is not completed at this time.



The Melbourne trailhead is located on the west side of Highway 330. The Iowa 330 Trail is completed to Highway 30. The Marshall County Conservation Board is currently working to complete a trail from Highway 30 to the Grimes Nature Farm. There is a completed trail from the Grimes Nature Farm into Marshalltown.
