

Frequently Asked Questions

1. HOW LONG CAN I STAY AT BURT LAKE, SIEMS PARK, OR SMITH LAKE SOUTH?

- 14 DAYS MAX STAY WITH A 3 DAY MINIMUM VACANCY
 - DURING MAY 12 – SEPTEMBER 8, 2025

2. WHAT ARE THE CAMPING RATES?

- \$10/NIGHT NON-ELECTRIC \$15/NIGHT ELECTRIC
 - IF CAMPING ON AN ELECTRIC SITE, YOU PAY THE ELECTRIC RATE
- SMITH LAKE NORTH CAMPING (FULL HOOK-UP) RATES ARE \$20/NIGHT, \$500/MONTH (EVERY 30 DAYS), SEASONAL APPLICATIONS SEE STAFF

3. HOW CAN I PAY FOR CAMPING?

- CASH, CHECK (made out to KCCB), and CARD (scan QR code)
 - CHANGE IS NOT MADE, CARDS HAVE ASSOCIATED FEES
 - CARD PAYMENTS ARE NOW AVAILABLE BY SCANNING THE QR CODE ON THE SITE POST MARKER DESIGNATED CARD PAY.

4. IS THERE A CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN TIME?

- YES. CHECK OUT IS AT 3PM CHECK IN IS AT 4PM

5. WHAT TIME IS QUIET HOURS?

- 10:30PM – 7AM RESPECT YOUR NEIGHBOR!

6. HOW DO I RESERVE A CAMPING SITE? WHAT SITES ARE WALK-INS OR ONLINE RESERVATION SITES?

- WALK-IN SITES ARE MARKED WITH A GREEN site # & ONLINE RESERVATION SITES ARE MARKED WITH A RED site #
 - TO RESERVE A WALK-IN SITE: MUST HAVE CAMPING UNIT/VEHICLE ON SITE, MUST HAVE REGISTRATION TAG PLACED ON POST, AND MUST HAVE PAYMENT (YOU PAY FOR THE TIME YOU OCCUPY THE SITE EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT ACTIVELY CAMPING EACH NIGHT)
 - TO RESERVE AN ONLINE RESERVATION SITE: GO TO <https://www.mycountyparks.com/County/Kossuth/Facility/Search>
 - MUST RESERVE ONLINE MINIMUM OF 5 DAYS PRIOR TO DESIRED STAY

7. HOW MANY CAMPING UNITS ALLOWED ON EACH SITE?

- ONE CAMPER AND ONE TENT PER SITE
OR
- 2 TENTS PER SITE

8. CAN I CAMP ON A MARKED/DESIGNATED ONLINE RESERVATION SITE? HOW DO I KNOW IF THE ONLINE RESERVATION SITE IS RESERVED?

- YES! BUT ALL ONLINE RESERVATIONS WILL TAKE PREFERENCE
 - SCAN QR CODE ON SITE MARKER POST TO FIND CALENDAR TO DETERMINE IF SITE IS OPEN FOR YOUR DESIRED STAY ON THE RESERVATION SITE
- ONLINE RESERVATIONS SITES WILL BE MARKED WITH A PINK PRINTED REGISTRATION TAG IF THEY ARE RESERVED FOR THAT WEEK
