CAMPGROUND RULES FOR SIEMS PARK 05/15/25

- 1. The campground is open from mid-April to October 31, weather permitting. Camping is allowed only in designated areas.
- 2. The maximum speed in the park is 5 mph.
- 3. Registrations must be completed within one hour of selecting a camping site. Check out time is 3:00 P.M. The registration envelope stub must be placed on the numbered post next to the campsite. One camper or trailer allowed per pad or a maximum of two tents on the gravel pad per site. One tent may be set up with camper or trailer at no extra charge. A maximum of two vehicles are allowed at each individual site.
- 4. Fees are \$10.00 per night for tent camping in the designated tent camping areas and \$15.00 per night for numbered sites. There is a 2-week max stay limit with a 3-day vacancy during the time period of May12-September 8, 2025. Camping Unit(s) and Occupant(s) MUST physically leave for the 3-day vacancy period. Outside of this time period, all sites are available as walk-in sites with no stay limit.
- 5. Visitors shall leave at 10:30 P.M. Quiet hours are 10:30 P.M.-7A.M.
- 6. There are 13 online reservable sites and 12 walk-in sites. The walk-in sites are available on a first come first served basis. The walk-in sites must be paid for, properly tagged and occupied by a camper, erected tent, trailer or a vehicle to be considered valid. Reservations for the reservable sites must be made a minimum of 5 days in advance at https://www.mycountyparks.com/County/Kossuth. Pending no reservation site is available as a walk-in. ALL RESERVATIONS WILL TAKE PRECEDENCE.
- 7. Pets must be controlled at all times.
- 8. Campers must move all vehicles, lawn chairs, etc. off the grass and onto the camping pads to allow for mowing. All sliders must also be moved in to allow for mowing. Campers are to be parked on the gravel lot. Rugs and mats are not permitted on the grass area.
- 9. The enclosed shelter house may be reserved for a fee of \$25.00. The hours for the shelter use are 6:00 A.M. to 10:30 P.M. Reservations must be made a minimum of 3 days in advance of the desired date at https://www.mycountyparks.com/County/Kossuth. If there are no reservations, the shelter is available for free on a first come first serve basis.
- 10. The use of the north shelter is free for day use only from 6:00 A.M. to 10:30 P.M. To reserve this shelter, contact the KCCB staff at 515-295-2138. If there are no reservations, the shelter is available for free on a first come first served basis.
- 11. The Kossuth County Conservation Board will not be held responsible for any injury or damages to personal property resulting from the ordinary use of the camping facilities.
