CAMPGROUND RULES FOR BURT LAKE 05/15/25

- 1. The campground is open from mid-April to October 31, weather permitting. Camping is allowed only in designated areas.
- 2. The maximum speed in the park is 5 mph.
- Registrations must be completed within one hour of selecting a camping site. The camping
 registration envelopes and the registration drop box is located on the east side of the open
 shelter. The registration envelope must be placed on the numbered wooden site post located
 near the site.
- 4. Fees are \$10.00 per night for tent camping and \$15.00 per night for electrical sites. There is a 2-week max stay limit with a 3-day vacancy during the time period of May12-September 8, 2025. Camping Unit(s) and Occupants MUST physically leave for the 3-day vacancy. Outside of this time period, all sites are available with no stay limit.
- 5. There are 10 electrical walk-in sites that are first come first served. Sites must be paid for, have a camping registration envelope displayed on the site post and have a tent, camper or vehicle physically on the site to be considered valid.
- 6. One camper or trailer allowed per site or a maximum of two tents (on the gravel pad) per site. One tent may be set up in addition to the camper or trailer at no extra charge. A maximum of two vehicles are allowed at each individual site.
- 7. Check out time is 3:00 P.M.
- 8. Each electrical site is allowed the shared use of one 30/50-amp electrical outlet and one 110 electrical outlet.
- 9. Quiet hours are 10:30 P.M.-7A.M.
- 10. Pets must be controlled at all times.
- 11. Campers must move all vehicles, lawn chairs, etc. off the grass and onto the camping pads to allow for mowing. All sliders must also be moved in to allow for mowing. Campers are to be parked on the gravel lot. Rugs and mats are not permitted on the grass area.
- 12. The shelter is available for free on a first come first served basis.
- 13. The Kossuth County Conservation Board will not be held responsible for any injury or damages to personal property resulting from the ordinary use of the camping facilities.
